

Mooloolaba Rotary has been associated with Equine Therapy for eleven years, supplying two drivers each session to transport students, and it is pleasing to have an enthusiastic Kawana Waters State College on board.

Launch of the Buddina Ocean Chair

On Friday 13 June, Charles Godfrey and Sandra Harrington represented Mooloolaba Rotary at the launch of the Buddina Ocean Chair in Pike Park, Warana.

The Buddina Ocean Chair is the result of many Sunshine Coast organisations and individuals working together - Sunshine Coast Council, Buddina State School, Turtle Care, Mack Muckan from Undumbi Culture people, local artist and project coordinator Gretchen Keelty and Monte Lupo Arts.

The mosaic mural spans approximately 18 square metres and consists of 20,000 handmade tiles containing 16 poems written by Year 6 students from Buddina State School. The stoneware mosaic tiles which feature animals and plants endemic to the region were made by supported artists and professional sculptors from Monte Lupo Arts and 330 students from Buddina State School. A wonderful community achievement and worth visiting.

Both Dee and Joe have a long and distinguished Rotary history, holding many important roles within other clubs and at District level. Please see below an excerpt from Joe's 2021 Bio. They joined our club in July 2021 but due to Joe's deteriorating health, made the tough decision a couple of years ago to resign when Joe was diagnosed with another debilitating condition. They were an energetic and friendly couple and we were sorry to see them go but fully understood the reasons why they made that decision. On behalf of the club I have written to Dee to express our condolences on the passing of Joe.

An excerpt from Joe's Bio in 2021:

"I joined the Rotary Club of Bundaberg West D9570 on 1 August 1989. I held various director's positions in my time with RC Bundaberg West. I then moved to RC Balmoral in July 2000 until June 2021.

My history with Youth Exchange: Host parent from 1996 to 2014 with RC Bundaberg West and RC Balmoral. We also hosted for RC Mt Gravatt and RC Wynnum & Manly. Dee (my wife) and I have hosted a total of 11 students over a long period as fulltime host parents. We have also hosted many short term (STEP) students. We also served as the alternate Brisbane Airport Liaison Officer and were regularly called upon to meet and collect Inbound students late at night from Brisbane Airport on their way to other destinations in Queensland. I served on the D9630 YEP Committee in many positions from 2003 until 2011. The last 3 years on the Committee as District Chair."
