



Interact - Our Club History and Support - Talk 9th June 2025

Interact is part of the Rotary International family of clubs, with:

Earlyact - 5 to 12 yo (primary school)

Interact - 12 to 18yo (secondary school)

Rotaract - 18 to 30yo (tertiary and others)

<u>Rotary</u> - Usually older folk but definitely not "passed it"!!

Our club is a proud and active supporter of Earlyact, Interact and now Rotaract here on the Sunshine Coast. Not many clubs can say they have the full list of the complete Rotary International family of clubs!!

Our involvement with Interact goes back to 1986 when the ILC Interact Club was chartered...have not seen the charter document but 1986 is the date of the first collar bar on the Presidential Chain. This means the 40 year anniversary is next year, 2026.time to celebrate!!

With a little digging (thanks President Ian and PPs Mike Ivess and Cathy Wright) since 1986, we have had 5 Rotarians from this club step forward as our representatives to the ILC Interact Club:

PP Bob Smith, PP Noel Bridges, PP and Honorary Member Arthur Hodge, PP Cathy Wright and now Andrew B.

The latest figures show that Interact service clubs are found in 145 countries, 14,911 clubs and over 340,000 members with 30,000 plus in Australia.

We also have the privilege to sponsor an Interact Club at Kawana Waters State College with Dept. Principal Anne Allen as our representative and Teacher Sponsor.

Back to the ILC Interact Club, meetings are on Thursdays with around 25 members present. The club has many projects where it raises funds for chosen charities, local, national and international. Last year the club raised over \$11,000. More importantly than money, Interact offers opportunities for leadership, teamwork and instilling a volunteering culture.

College management is fully supportive of the club and offer our incoming exchange students (Pelle from Denmark is commencing at ILC on 14th July) free tuition. We assist with club support and our expertise in parking cars for the college's main fundraiser the Fruehlingsfest, a Youth project we have undertaken since 2007. A plug.the rosters are now up on the member's website for Saturday, 30th August..be quick!!

Finally, at the Interact meeting last Thursday, I told the members that I would be speaking tonight and asked them what they would like me to share with our club.A "big thank you" for our support was the unanimous response. I also took the opportunity to say what impressed me since I began attending their meetings, 2 impressions being:

- 1. The way the club manages their projects, their enthusiasm and the way volunteers come forward to work on the variety of fundraisers, a number are before/after college hours and some on weekends.
- 2. The dedication, leadership, devotion and love shown by their Teacher Sponsor, Ms Kirsten Zweck PHF. Kirsten is a treasure and she has been involved with Interact for the last 10 years...told the club they are most fortunate to have such a wonderful and dedicated person as their guide and college mentor.

Family Service satellite club is kid-friendly

As a mom of four little kids, I wanted to find a better way to share the joy of Rotary with my children. My goal was to form a Family Service club.

To my delight, our Bloomington Sunrise club agreed to sponsor a family service satellite club. A satellite club provided me with the support I needed in the following ways:

- We only needed to find eight new members, not the 20 required to start a new club (*as of 1 July the required number for regular clubs will be 15 following* action by the Council on Legislation in April).
- We did not need to form our own board (I serve as Satellite Club Chair and sit on the Bloomington Sunrise Board as our representative).
- We can keep our dues affordable by only charging for Rotary International and District dues. Our home club treasurer creates and manages our invoicing and reporting.
- We also offer a unique second option of attendance for our current members, plus more ways to serve.

We chartered in the summer of 2024 with 10 primary members (nine new Rotarians and me). When you include spouses and kids, our small but mighty group includes 19 adults and 23 kids.

We have one service project each month and one meeting/social. We don't typically have speakers at our meetings, but we do meet at a kid-friendly play space so the kids can run around and the grownups can visit. This non-traditional club format is just what our members want. week. As natural leaders and doers, our parent members love being able to show up with their kids and serve others.Over the past year, our satellite club has completed over 300 hours of service.

The **Family Service Satellite Club** of Bloomington Sunrise has fulfilled my Rotary dream of being able to share the love of Rotary with our kids. I'm so thankful to my club (and my husband, who of course is also a Rotarian!) for supporting this vision.

Meeting of the Rotary Club of Mooloolaba held Jun 9 2025 6:00PM


There were 17 Members present along with 1 guests. We received 29 apologies. (More information can be obtained from our website.) Visitors at last meeting
