

- Notification from Club Mooloolaba that meal costs would rise from 24th March
 - o Meal costs will increase to \$27.50 from the 24th March to cover rising costs

About the Guest Speaker

It was my pleasure to host our Guest Speaker Antionette Lloyd at our meeting last Monday.

Antionette works with YouTurn, an organization that was formed in Noosa more than 30 years ago. Their Mission is to support people in their times of need to live a healthy and meaningful life. YouTurn is a "Not for Profit Organisation."

Antionette shared some brief statistics highlighting the extent the number of young people suffering some form of mental health. It is estimated that 40% of people aged 24 years and under suffer some form of mental health.

Antionett's presentation included a short video showing three live cases on issues leading to poor mental health.

YouTurn assists with child safety, supporting the homeless, general mental health and in suicide prevention. It was interesting to note eating disorders, bullying and financial issues were also raised.

During her presentation Antionette mentioned that in earlier times whilst living in South Africa she travelled to Texas USA as Rotary Youth Exchange Student.

Thank you Antionette for a professional and informative presentation, on a subject that is important to us all and a major focus to our Club.
